THEY'RE BACK - IT'S BEAR SEASON AGAIN!

At this time of year, there is little food for the bears - and they are wandering, looking for a meal, especially easy ones!

Springtime for some means those evening walks, and kids playing outside in the later evenings - this is difficult with bears wandering about. Many bears have been accustomed to human life, and wander around without fear.

Follow these simple instructions to minimize the chances of attracting bears:

- Store garbage in waste containers with tight-fitting lids.
- Put out garbage only on the morning of pick-up.
- Put away bird feeders. Seed, suet and nectar also attract bears.
- Do not leave pet food outdoors.
- Clean outdoor barbecue grills after each use, including the grease trap underneath.



Bears will be drawn by smells from great distances, including grease and food residue on grills.
