# MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION

## TO ACCESS INTERVAL/SAFE HOUSES

ONTARIO REGION - NON-INSURED HEALTH BENEFITS PROGRAM (NIHB)

To clarify the provision of medical transportation benefits to access interval/safe houses.

*Medical Transportation Policy Framework, Section 1.2* – Access to medically required health services may include financial assistance to the client or arranging for the provision of services from the reserve or community of residence when the following conditions are met:

b) Travel is to the nearest appropriate health professional or health facility (when health professionals are brought into the community to provide the service, the community facility is considered the nearest appropriate facility);

*Medical Transportation Policy Framework, Section 1.3* – Medical transportation benefits may be provided for clients to access the following types of medically required health services:

- Non-Insured Health Benefits (vision, dental, mental health).

*Medical Transportation Policy Framework, Section 12.1* – Certain types of travel, benefits, and services will NOT be provided as benefits under the NIHB Program under any circumstances and are not subject to the NIHB appeal process. These include assistance with:

...

k) Transportation to adult day care, respite care and/or interval/safe houses.

### Application

Section 12.1 is hereby amended to remove “interval/safe houses” as exclusion under the MT Policy Framework. For greater clarity, access to interval/safe houses may be considered a “medically required health service” for the purpose of sections 1.2 & 1.3 of the Framework.

Transportation benefits will be arranged as per the terms and conditions of the NIHB Medical Transportation Policy Framework:

# NON-INSURED HEALTH BENEFITS

## ONTARIO REGION

### MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION ESCORT CRITERIA

#### PURPOSE

To clarify the criteria for the coverage of non-medical escorts under the national NIHB Medical Transportation Policy Framework.

#### Medical Justification for Non-Medical Escort:

A note/form signed by a doctor or community health professional is not required (escorts should automatically be approved) in support of a claim for a non-medical escort where:

- the client is a minor (validation using client's date of birth);
- the request is for travel to undergo a procedure as part of which the client will receive sedation (if it is evident that the client will be unable to travel home unaccompanied following the procedure);
- there is existing documentation in the client's file that supports the continuing need for a non-medical escort for reasons such as:
  - a language barrier;
  - escort travel previously approved as part of a series of related treatments; or
  - a health professional has previously indicated that client has a permanent condition and will always require assistance while travelling.

In other situations, the health professional is requested to specify what function the escort is to provide, (i.e. client requires physical support from escort, or client requires escort for cognitive support etc.). In exceptional cases of requests for multiple escorts, more detailed information regarding the client's need for supports may be required however information on the client's medical diagnosis is not required. The medical justification provided will be documented. In exceptional circumstances where verbal justification is provided, the documentation will include the name of the official taking the information, date and time, along with the name of the requesting health professional.

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# PRE NATAL ESCORTS

## NEW FUNDING FOR NIHB

BUDGET 2017

### To provide important information regarding new funding for NIHB.

Budget 2017 includes proposals for new funding for NIHB in a number of key areas. This includes expanding the medical transportation benefit to ensure that expecting mothers do not have to travel alone if they require medical transportation outside the community to deliver their babies.

### Prenatal Escorts

NIHB will approve requests for non-medical escorts for women travelling for child birth, without requesting additional medical or legal reason for the escort.

Please ensure eligible clients are made aware so they can take advantage of this benefit enhancement.

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
