Forestry 2023/24 Annual Work Schedules

The draft Annual Work Schedules for the Algoma, Missinaibi, and White River forests have been made available to MFN to review and identify values that could be impacted by forestry operations

Annual Work Schedules identify where forestry operations are scheduled to occur in the next year (April 1, 2023 - March 31st, 2024).

Forestry operations include activities such as:

- **Harvesting (logging)**
- **Road Construction**
- **Tree Planting**
- **Aerial Herbicide Spraying**
- **Prescribed Burns**
