

## CIS Application Requirements – ID

Applicants must provide proof of their identity to the Issuing Officer (Jenny Fletcher – IRA for Michipicoten First Nation) along with their CIS Application form before the card can be issued.

Identity documents are separated by the following categories:

### Identification requirements for applicants who are 16 years of age or older:

- One piece of Primary ID (Category 1);
- Two pieces of Secondary ID (Category 2) and one must have a digitized photo;
- One piece of Secondary ID with a Guarantor Declaration (Category 3).

### Identification requirements for applicants who are younger than 12 years of age:

The parent/legal guardian must provide:

- One piece of their own Primary ID (Category 1) or Secondary ID (Category 2);
- One piece of ID for the child (Birth document, School ID, Health Card);
- If a legal guardian is applying on the behalf of the child or dependent adult, a copy of the Order of Guardianship naming the guardian is required.
